Louisiana Moms: LaPRAMS may need your help!

What is LaPRAMS*?

LaPRAMS is a survey that asks new moms questions about their pregnancy and their new baby.



Why are my answers important?

LaPRAMS helps us find out why some babies are born healthy and others are not. Your answers help to improve programs for Louisiana moms and babies in the future.

How does LaPRAMS work?

Every month, about 200 new moms in Louisiana with babies between 2-6 months old are picked at random to take part in the LaPRAMS survey.

If you are picked:

- LaPRAMS will contact you by mail.
- If you don't send in your completed survey by mail, LaPRAMS will contact you by phone.

Once you finish the survey or tell us that you are not interested, LaPRAMS will no longer contact you.

Is my information confidential?

Yes, all information collected by LaPRAMS is confidential.

What do I get for participating?

If you are picked to complete the survey, you will get a CD of nursery rhymes to enjoy with your baby.

If you finish and send in the survey on time, you'll get a \$20 gift card to thank you for your time.
